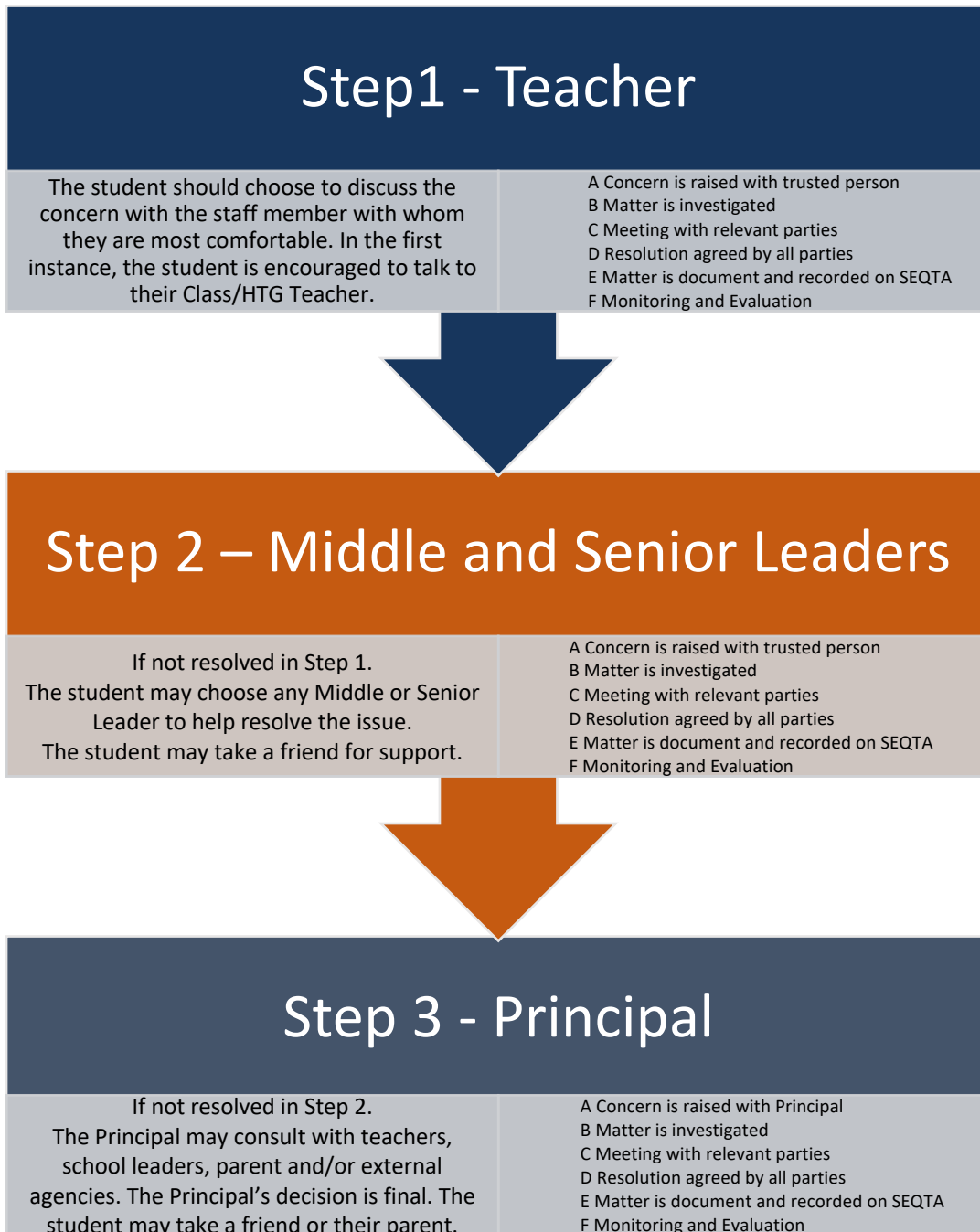


The College recognises the right of an individual student to feel free to voice a concern and will endeavour to investigate, address and, if required, resolve that concern in an open and fair manner.

If a student has a concern that they would like addressed the guidelines below should be followed:



Students should be aware that in some instances confidentiality cannot be guaranteed if the matter is serious or criminal in nature. Students need to be aware that College staff may be obliged to share information with relevant school Leaders and/or Wellbeing staff, Police or outside agency dependent on the nature of the concern.

Note that teachers and some other employees have mandatory reporting obligations under the Children and Community Services Act 2004 (WA) if they have reasonable grounds to suspect a child is at risk of sexual harm and have current concerns about the wellbeing of the child.
