Dear Parents/Guardians

I apologise for the number of communications at the moment, but we are in new territory in regard to managing a significant event of the scale of COVID-19.

At this stage, the College is fully operational and delivering classes with a few modifications around social distancing, restrictions to external visitors, no large gatherings, limited excursions and offsite events and an increased focus on personal hygiene.

Health authorities have advised that schools will remain open for the time being. Where parents choose to keep their children home to self-isolate, are in quarantine due to recent overseas travel, have had contact with a person who has COVID-19 or are sick students may access work that is normally available online however; staff will not be available during class times to interact with students studying from home. Furthermore, there will be no capacity for students to undertake assessments from home. Our plan for full online delivery will not be operational unless a full school closure is enacted.

Our current priority is to provide normal classroom delivery of lessons and, as such, children should be attending school.
