Dear Parents/Guardians

I am writing to provide an update on the College's current position regarding attendance by parents/guardians and family members at College events.

During the school holidays the Western Australian Premier, Hon Mark McGowan MLA, announced that the State of Western Australia (WA) will continue with Phase Four COVID-19 restrictions. A further update from the WA Department of Health is expected on 1 August 2020.

Under COVID-19 Stage Four, gathering limits are still determined by the 2 square metre rule. The College is required to adhere to this regulation in regard to adults present on College grounds. Unfortunately, the College is not in a position to manage large groups of adults at College events to ensure compliance with this restriction. Therefore, until further notice parents/guardians and family members are unable to attend College events.

The Western Australian government has advised that the proposed date for moving into Phase Five is 1 August 2020 at which time this restriction is anticipated to be lifted. Once this shift occurs, the College will revisit the potential for parents/guardians and family members to attend College events.

COVID-19 Stage Four restrictions will however, allow a number of larger events to be held with students only. These include:

- Junior School Assemblies
- Friday Gospel Reflection
- Junior School Disco and Middle School Social
- Middle and Senior School Athletics Carnival
- Junior School Athletics Carnival
- Middle School NEAS Sports

Where possible, the College will endeavour to 'live stream' significant events.

At this time the College is planning LIFE Week to operate as normal as possible. Information regarding LIFE Week will be forwarded to parents shortly.

Arrangements for events such as the College Feast Day, Year 12 Graduation and Annual Celebration evening will depend on further easing of the COVID-19 Restrictions.

I am grateful for your ongoing support and I am hopeful that Western Australia continues to overcome the challenges of the coronavirus pandemic.
