Dear parents and caregivers

I am writing to let you know that free RATs for each student have now been delivered to the school.

These free RATs will support our students to continue to attend school for face-to-face learning and will minimise disruption to their schooling. You will be able to test your child at home if they are feeling unwell. You can also use these RATs if your child is a close contact to enable them to test daily and continue to attend school, as long as they receive a negative result, remain asymptomatic, and wear a mask if they are in Year 7 and above. I attach a letter from WA Health which explains how to use the RATs.

Please be mindful that while these RATs are safe for use by children, they should only be administered under the supervision of an appropriate adult.

We will start handing out these RATs from Monday 16 May to Friday 20 May.

All RATs will be handed out to parents/caregivers from our Administration area from 8:00am until 4:00pm. We have sufficient numbers for all families so please consider the timeliness of your collection to avoid crowds.

If you cannot collect your RAT's next week, please let Administration staff know. Only Secondary students can collect the RAT's at the end of the day, with your consent. Junior School parents RAT's can be stored for collection the following week if required.

If your child becomes symptomatic, they should stay home and be tested for COVID-19. You should notify the school if your child tests positive for COVID-19. Refer to [healthy.wa.gov.au](https://www.health.wa.gov.au) for information on close contact definition, testing and isolation requirements.

Thank you for your continued efforts in keeping our school COVID-19 safe.
