Position Description

The Home Economics Assistant holds a pivotal role in facilitating the effective delivery of food and nutrition education within the Technologies Learning Area. This position supports both the practical and theoretical components of the curriculum by ensuring that food technology classes are well-prepared, efficiently run, and aligned with contemporary health and safety standards. Operating within a Catholic school setting, the FHome Economics Assistant is expected to model and promote the values of Catholic education: fostering a safe, inclusive, and engaging learning environment that encourages creativity, responsibility, and collaboration.

A genuine passion for food education is essential, as the Home Economics Assistant will play a key role in fostering student engagement and curiosity about nutrition, culinary skills, and safe food practices. Equally important is a collaborative spirit and a commitment to educational excellence, as the technician will work closely with teaching staff to enhance student learning experiences and contribute to a positive and inclusive learning environment.

The Home Economics Assistant reports to the Learning Area Leader - Technologies. This is a 0.5FTE ongoing position which commences in January 2026.

Responsibilities

Community and Pastoral Care

- Collaborate respectfully with students and staff, offering guidance and encouragement during practical lessons
- Contribute to the holistic development of students by nurturing life skills such as teamwork, responsibility, and resilience
- Support students with diverse needs by adapting resources and providing practical assistance during classes

Education and Learning

- Prepare ingredients, equipment, and resources to support the delivery of food and nutrition curriculum
- Assist teachers during practical classes to ensure safe, engaging, and effective student participation
- Support curriculum delivery through resource organisation, recipe preparation, and alignment with learning outcomes
- Maintain accurate documentation and records to support assessment, audits, and compliance with educational standards

Catholic Identity and Faith

- Support and uphold the Catholic faith, vision and mission of Holy Cross College in all practices.
- Model Gospel values such as compassion, respect, and integrity in interactions with students, families, and staff.
- Ensure that all interactions align with the Bishops of WA Mandate and the College's Vision and Mission fostering a learning environment that honours the dignity of each person and promotes stewardship, hospitality, and care.

Stewardship

- Monitor and manage stock levels of food, equipment, and consumables to ensure efficient use of resources
- Order supplies in consultation with the Learning Area Leader Technologies, maintaining budget awareness
