The successful candidate will be responsible for the planning, coordination, and management of Inter-house Carnivals and will work collaboratively with other schools in the planning and delivery of CPSSA Inter-school carnivals.

As a collaborative member of the Primary team, the Physical Education Teacher will work closely with colleagues and families to build positive relationships and contribute to a supportive, faith-filled school community. Strong communication skills, organisational ability and flexibility are essential.

The Physical Education Teacher will report to the Assistant Principal of the Junior School and the Head of Primary.

- Planning and delivering engaging, age-appropriate Physical Education lessons aligned to curriculum requirements.
- Assessing and monitoring student progress using data-informed practices to inform teaching and learning.
- Differentiating instruction to cater for a diverse range of abilities and needs.
- Planning, coordinating, and managing Interhouse Carnivals (including Athletics, Cross Country, and Swimming).

Catholic Identity and Faith

- Serve as a positive Catholic role model for students in all interactions.
- Willingness to engage in ongoing spiritual and theological formation, remaining informed and responsive to the teachings of the Catholic Church.
- Ensure that Catholic perspectives and moral teachings are woven throughout the curriculum reinforcing the College's Catholic identity.
